Skatepark Update – October 2022

We are delighted to report that the plans for our new skatepark at Fingerpost Field have been validated. This means that the planning application process has started, and we are much closer to providing this facility for the community. We are aware that our younger residents have been without a skatepark for some time and so we hope that the application process is quick with plans approved so that work can start as soon as possible. The success of the application will depend on the amount of support from Ringmer residents, so if you are in favour please take the time to add a comment in support of the application. It only takes a few minutes and will be important in showing the Planning Committee the level of support from residents.

You may have heard that the housing application from Croudace, currently being appealed, includes a proposal for a skatepark. The Community Land Trust (CLT) has agreed with Croudace to manage some of the community facilities promised as part of the housing development. The CLT have undertaken to discuss with the Parish Council the provision of a skatepark as part of those plans, if it is approved.

Fingerpost Field is our best chance of providing a skatepark for our residents in a timely manner.
